Small Grants Programme

You can:

- Apply anytime for up to £1000
- Expect a decision within 14 days
- Apply to this programme up to twice in any three year period
- Draw down two year's funding in one (as long as £2000 limit per three year period not exceeded)

Applications should:

- *Not exceed one side of A4*
- *Provide a budget*
- *Be linked to your mission plan (please provide details)*

All grant applications (to either fund) need to be discussed and agreed at a PCC/DCC meeting. Please include the minute of this decision with your application.

Please provide bank account details for payment (funds will be transferred by BACS within 21 days of the funding decision. PCC/DCC accounts only)

- There is no restriction on the number of applications you can make to the Large Grants Programme as long as the applications are for different projects.

Large Grants Programme

You can:

- Apply in March, June and September for amounts over £1000 and not exceeding £15000
- Expect a decision within 3 months (you may be asked to give a presentation or submit further details in that time)
- Expect each application to be assessed on its merit and with regard to available funds.

Applications should:

- *Provide a budget (and exit funding strategy if appropriate)*
- *Provide appropriate mechanisms for the employment of personnel (if salaries requested – no facility exists within the deanery itself)*
- *Be linked to your mission plan (please provide details)*

Successful grants will:

- Directly contribute to and support the missional life of the deanery through collaboration with others
- Be evaluated by serious reflection on completion of the project
- Only be used to support activities and projects which have been properly risk assessed and insured, with appropriate procedures and protection policies in place (child, vulnerable adult, Health and Safety etc.)

The liability for any activity or project DMG supports is retained by the applicant.
